- **Opening Date Goal: 9/6/11**

Lord willing, we will welcome our first patients in about 4 months!

- **Location: 502 S. Morris**

This is the former St. Joseph's Hospital site, in the heart of west Bloomington.

- **501(c)3 status from the IRS**

- **City of Bloomington funding**

The City approved \$50,000 from the Community Development Block Grant for Building Renovations. Thank you, Bloomington!

- **Pro Forma financial plans completed**

Startup costs are estimated at \$133,000; ongoing annual needs are likely to be close to \$150,000

- **Floor Plan Completed**

It's beautiful! We plan to begin renovations in July.

**ISU Students Complete Needs
Analysis**

A group of ISU students under the direction of Dr. Jim Cox recently completed a formal analysis for IHC. They surveyed 117 people from west Bloomington neighborhoods and two local food pantries. Conclusion?

There is a great demand for a health center in west

Bloomington! Here are a few of their responses:

- 76% are very likely to seek services at IHC
- 54% would like prayer at the Center
- 35% would like counseling
- 55% report incomes below \$20,000

The students also made recommendations on advertising, hours, and staffing for us. This will be a great resource as we seek to reach out to the neighborhoods near the health center.
